Exit I- 80 at Monte Vista Avenue/Allison Drive exit.
Keep to your left.
At the stop light turn left onto Monte Vista Ave.
Turn left at the next traffic light onto Allison Drive (you will go over the freeway).
Turn left onto Ulatis Drive. Community Center on right.

From Bay Area (Eastbound)
