▶ **Question 1: What do you see as the biggest barriers to successfully managing recreation in combination with wildlife conservation?**

▶ **Question 2: What types of restrictions and constraints to how conservation lands are used do you see as being the most valuable, but least socially acceptable, to minimize recreation effects on wildlife (i.e., what measures provide the greatest payoff but possibly require the greatest upfront effort or cost)? How can managers best discuss those restrictions and constraints in a way that engages, but does not antagonize, public land users?**

▶ **Question 3: What additional research on recreation impacts to wildlife do you feel would be the most useful for future management and planning efforts? How specifically would this information be used?**

▶ **Question 4: How can conservation land professionals best engage with recreation interest groups in land planning and management to work together for mutual interests in protecting natural areas for recreation, conservation, or both types of uses instead of becoming increasingly divided over conflicts between recreation and conservation?**
